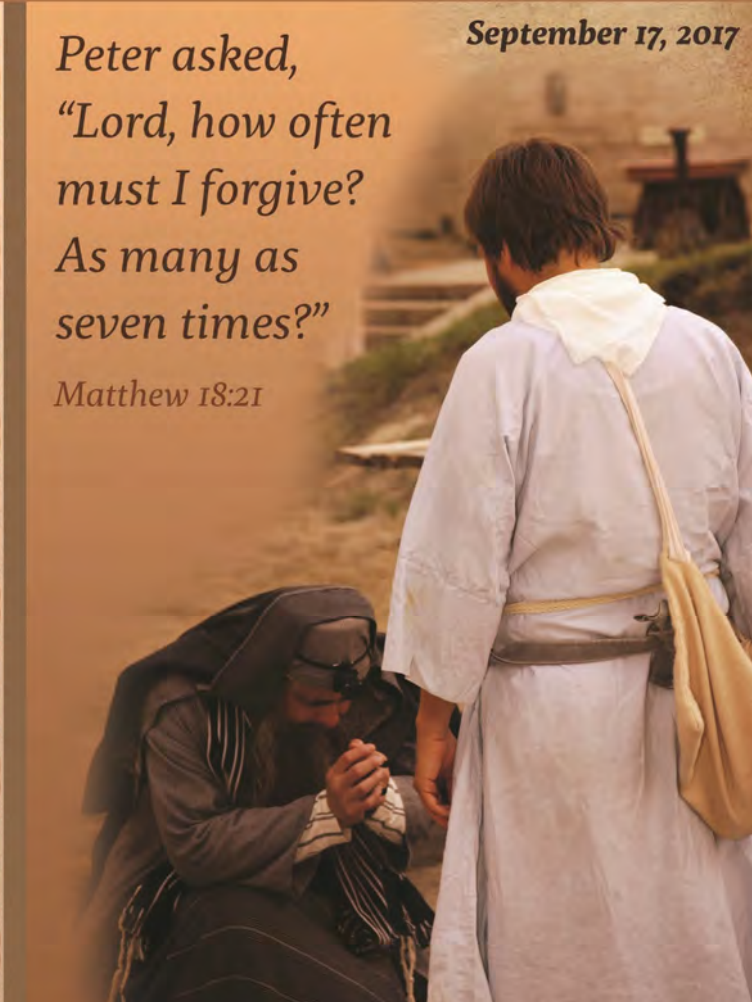

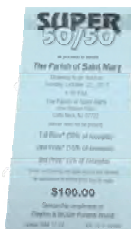

Please be sure to have several options for your desired dates so we can accommodate you properly.

Three intentions are accepted for all scheduled Masses, except for Ash Wednesday, Christmas, Easter and the Sacred Triduum. It is appropriate for you or the family of the deceased to attend the Mass when celebrated. The suggested stipend for a Mass intention is \$10.00 & has been set by the N.J. Bishops in the Province of Newark.

Every effort will be made to satisfy all requests, however in some cases the intention availability for a date you are requesting may be filled before your appointment and you will be asked to choose another date.

After initial Mass Book opening, requests may be submitted using this multi-intention form or a Mass Request Envelope. Availability of dates is on a first-come first served basis.

*The members of the Mass Book team do not have authority to make exceptions,
so please do not ask them to do so.*

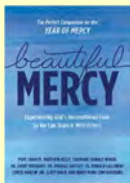
