It's the Great Recovery, Charlie Brown! Festive Autumn greetings to all! As we approach the conclusion of another liturgical year at the end of next month, it's a great time to look ahead and make those "new year's resolutions". The music ministry is getting ready to embark on an expedition to recover much of the lost sacred music that has always been important our Catholic identity. As intense as that sounds, the congregation has already experienced a foretaste of it...in polyphonic motets on Solemnities, in the Roman Missal Mass setting, in the reintroduced ancient chants (In Paradisum, Veni Creator Spiritus, etc), and in the variety of processions we have been proud to incorporate throughout the year.

Recently, the choir learned and sang 'Panis Angelicus' (Bread of Angels) as a post-communion. In the upcoming months, we will implement this and a few others into the congregation that are befitting of edifying the liturgy, and conversely, ourselves.

Additionally, November is the month of All Saints and All Souls. Every Sunday, until the Solemnity of Jesus Christ the King of the Universe, we will chant the Litany of Saints as the Communion Procession, but more on that next time.

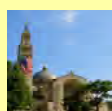

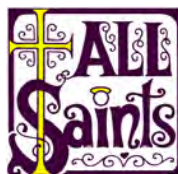

My Dear Parishioners:

Today we celebrate the Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Without persistence in prayer it will be impossible for us to follow Jesus faithfully on the road of self-giving. The encounter with Jesus in prayer keeps healthy and strong our relationship to him. The prayer of petition reminds us that disciples can do nothing on their own without Jesus' help. Only with Jesus will we disciples not stumble (see first reading). The paschal mystery rhythm of dying and rising plays itself out in many ways—this Sunday in a rhythm of ministry and prayer. In practical everyday terms, this means that at times we are *doing* our faith — reaching out to those around us in need and at other times we are *being* our faith — taking time to let our God be present to us in prayer.

Thanks to all those who sacrificially supported the Annual World Mission Sunday Collection. These resources are used to continue the mission of the Church to evangelize every corner of the earth. Our participation continues to show forth the true universality of the Catholic Church. Thank you for welcoming our guest homilist last weekend representing food for the poor. Next week, we begin the month of November... the month of All Saints and All Souls. This is an important part of our Christian Spirituality. Each of us is called to holiness. the intercession of the saints may we continue to model our faith to those around us at home and in the work place. Let us ever be mindful of the need to pray for the repose of the souls of those who have gone before us. They are very effective in ministering to those who experience the death of a loved one. We also thank those who help to facilitate bereavement ministry in our parish. Walking with those who have experienced the death of a loved one is central to our understanding of the paschal mystery.

It is my hope that you will receive our Annual Parish Stewardship Report shortly. Many thanks to all those staff members and parishioners who have made this publication possible. Please take time to read it carefully and become better informed parishioners and stakeholders in the mission of our parish. We continue to make slow, steady progress toward our parish goal for the 2015 Annual Catholic Appeal. Thanks to all those who have made their gift. There is still time to help us make our goal for this year. Have a great week. Let us remember one another in prayer. Happy Sunday.

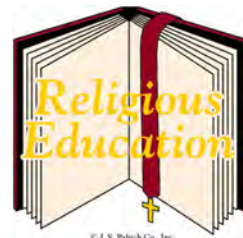

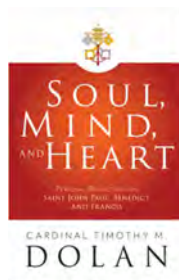
